

# The Diecasting Society AGM

Over 15 members, plus secretarial support, met for the Annual General Meeting of The Diecasting Society, held on 25 April at Thomas Dudley Ltd, in the West Midlands (UK).

Treasurer, Simon Olive, gave current details of the finances, including the investments, of the society, both of which are healthy, president Stuart Gregory then circulated a copy of the end of year accounts which were approved.

During the meeting, Olive tendered his resignation as DCS treasurer after eight years' service and was thanked by all for his diligence and work in preparing the accounts.

Following a proposal by Stuart Gregory, those present voted for a change in the DCS Constitution. The change will enable the society to provide DCS members with some financial support for apprentices, for example, help towards the cost of training courses. This support will replace the *Annual Apprentice Award* scheme.

The president gave a review of the past year's activities and discussed possible future events. It was noted that technical information is very important for members and the DCS would like to request technical papers to be submitted to the society so that it can organise a webinar event. #### Factory tour of Morgan Motor Company Malvern, Worcestershire


## Thursday 29th June 2023
